





- 1. USGA Rules govern all play except where modified by the Local Rules.
- 2. Boundaries
 - A. Out of Bounds: Defined by 'White' Stakes, Fences or the edge of the Street Curbs.
 - B. Red Staked Penalty Area: Defined by 'Red' stakes or lines.
 - C. Ground Under Repair: Defined by 'White' lines or 'Blue' stakes.
 - D. Environmentally Sensitive Areas (ESA): Defined by Signage and 'Red' stakes with 'Green' top.
- 3. (ESA) Environmentally Sensitive Areas: Holes #1, 2, 3, 4, 6, 8, 11 & 18

Are defined as Penalty Areas. These areas are defined by the inside edge of the 'Red' stakes with 'Green' top. The 'Red' line acts as the penalty area boundary. These areas are RESTRICTED AREAS, do not enter to retrieve or search for golf balls. If your ball is <u>Inside</u> the (ESA)/ Penalty Area, you must drop and take a one-shot penalty.

If your ball is <u>Outside</u> the (ESA)/Penalty Area, but your swing or stance is hindered by protected vegetation. Must take relief within one club length no closer to the hole, Free Drop.

- 4. Drop Circles Holes #4, 12 & 13 are for balls that are hit into the water penalty area only.
- 5. 'Shell Paths' & 'Pine Straw' areas are an integral part of the course; the ball must be 'played as it lies'.
- 6. Holes #3, 7, 10, 11 & 15 'Bulkheads' interfering with stance or swing is considered immovable obstructions, Free Drop.
- 7. Holes #12, 13 & 14 concrete 'Drainage Culverts' are deemed 'Ground Under Repair', Free Drop.
- 8. A player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only; if a player uses a distance measuring device that is designed to measure other conditions such as slope the penalty is disqualification.
- 9. 'Flower Beds' marked with a Blue Stake are considered 'Ground Under Repair', Free Drop.
- 10. '2 x 2 Rule' Sprinkler heads within two-club lengths of the putting surface, interfere with your line of play and the ball is within two club lengths of the sprinkler head. You may take relief nearest point no closer to the hole.
- 11. Stance or swing in newly sodded areas and sod seams are deemed 'Ground Under Repair', Free Drop.
- 12. Interference of stance or swing by newly planted trees are deemed 'Ground Under Repair', Free Drop.
