

PLANTATION GOLF & COUNTRY CLUB - LOCAL RULES
USGA RULES GOVERN ALL PLAY

- 1)** **IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTION CLOSE TO PUTTING GREEN:** Relief may be taken from intervention on the line of play provided the immovable obstruction is within two club lengths of the green and the ball is within two club lengths of the immovable obstruction in the general area. The player must lift the ball and drop it as near as possible to where the ball lay within one club length no nearer the hole, avoiding intervention and not in a hazard or on a putting green.
- 2)** **ABNORMAL GROUND CONDITIONS:** Relief must be taken in all newly sodded areas in the general area and on the putting green. Full relief must be taken. Relief may also be taken if your ball lies in an aerification hole in the general area or on the putting green. Debris piled in preparation for removal and any hole made by the maintenance staff, while removing a tree stump is ground under repair.
- 3)** Any ball hit over a water hazard into a development or onto a roadway is considered Out of Bounds.
- 4)** Wooden or stone retaining walls are considered an integral part of the golf course, not obstructions, no free relief.
- 5)** #13 Bobcat - Free Drop from shell cart paths unless the ball is in a Waste Area. The Waste Area is defined by blue stakes along the left water side.
